

Senior Geotechnical Engineer

This position's work will primarily be located at the project in Wells BC and will be on a 5 days on, 2 days off rotation.

Reporting directly to the Superintendent, Technical Services, the Senior Geotechnical Engineer will be responsible for ensuring the safe and stable design and operation of mines under the Cariboo Gold Project. This involves assessing soil, rock and ground conditions, developing ground control management plans, slope controls, foundational needs, and generally managing ground stability risks. Preventing issues of slope failures, landslides, and roof collapses, while considering environmental impacts and regulatory compliance. He/she will optimize productivity in accordance with goals and scheduling while demonstrating a strong personal commitment to safety and the environment.

Main Responsibilities

- Overseeing geotechnical aspects of projects, including scope definition, ground control, and reporting.
- Gathering, interpreting, and managing geotechnical data, including mapping, laboratory testing, and in-situ measurements, and utilizing numerical modeling tools to predict ground behavior.
- Conducting field observations and tests on soil and rock conditions to evaluate their properties and controls required for mining operations.
- Designing foundations for structures like mine openings, waste dumps, and tailings impoundments, considering load-bearing capacity, soil characteristics, and environmental factors.
- Assessing and mitigating risks associated with stability, and ground movement
- Installing and managing geotechnical monitoring systems, collecting and analyzing data, and reporting on ground conditions and potential hazards.
- Ensuring that mining operations adhere to relevant regulations and safety standards, including ground control management plans and hazard assessments.
- Collaborating with mine planning and operations teams to optimize mining methods, layouts, and sequences to minimize geotechnical risks and enhance productivity.
- Working with mining engineers, operations personnel, and other stakeholders to provide geotechnical expertise and support mine planning and operations.
- Providing technical guidance, mentoring junior engineers, and promoting best practices in geotechnical engineering within the organization.

- Considering the environmental impact of mining activities and implementing sustainable practices related to geotechnical aspects.
- Identifying, assessing, and mitigating geotechnical risks to prevent accidents and ensure the safety of personnel and infrastructure.
- Effectively communicating technical findings and recommendations to various stakeholders, including management, operations teams, and regulatory bodies
