

## Senior Resource Geologist

- Investigate improved techniques for resource estimation and delineation
- Manage 3<sup>rd</sup> party consultants or contractors as it relates to resource estimation and resource audits
- Preparing detailed reports on resource estimations, including maps, presentations, diagrams, and interpretations for public disclosures and internal requirements.
- Training new geological field staff in resource estimation and build an adequate support team to maintain the highest quality possible, within approved budgets, for resource estimation
- Collaborating with the technical services and production departments to assist, as required, updating of reserve statements, reconciliation reporting, resource to reserve conversion prioritization and future planning and budgeting
- Working with the exploration group, assist in the exploration and development programs to test new targets
- Ensure all environmental standards and safe practices are adhered to
