

Hydrogeologist (Hydrotechnical Scientist)

About the Site:

- BGM's gold exploration operations are located near the town of Wells, British Columbia.
- Wells has a population of about 250 residents and has a long history of gold mining and exploration dating back to the 1800s.

As a Hydrogeologist/ Hydro technologist for BGM, you will implement the groundwater and hydrometric monitoring programs. You will be responsible for data compilation, interpretation and reporting. The successful candidate will also support other environmental activities for the project.

Main Responsibilities

- Supervision of BGM environmental technicians, summer students;
- Implement components of current environmental monitoring and sampling programs, sampling and management of reporting regimes at BGM sites;
- Performing internal inspections and facilitating regulatory inspections;
- Assisting in the formulation, preparation and implementation of environmental programs, schedules and budgets;
- Report writing, data analysis, scheduling, report editing/production, statistical analysis;
- Demonstration of leadership in health and environmental matters ensuring that unsafe practices or non-compliant behaviors do not occur;
- Maintaining positive relationships, representing BGM positively in the community;
- Performing other environmental related duties as required.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in Hydrogeology, Physical Geography, Biology, Earth, Hydrotechnical Engineering, Environmental Science, Resource Management or other related discipline (recent Graduates will be considered)
- Strong organizational and time management skills
- Valid driver's license class 5
- Safety conscious
- Working knowledge of British Columbia and Canadian environmental regulations, guidelines, and standards
- Innovation and proven ability to work well with others with demonstrated problem-solving skills
- Candidates must be eligible to work in Canada
