- Participate in the review of payment batches;
- Present monthly accounts in an accurate and timely manner for consolidated monthly and quarterly reporting;

- Prepare leases movement schedule;
- Prepare mining interest and PP&E movement schedules;
- Participate in the maintenance of the Asset Register and Depreciation Schedules;
- Reconcile bank statements and resolve discrepancies;

- Prepare journal entries for accruals, corrections, and adjustments;
- Participate in the month end closing process including all related ledger reconciliation;
