Reporting to the Health and Safety Superintendent, the Health and Safety Advisor will help ensure the health, safety, and security of Barkerville Gold Mines Ltd. employees by implementing and supporting health and safety initiatives. They will be committed to communicating safety policies and serving as a resource for employees.

This will be a 6-month contract, accommodations will be provided, 14 days in, 14 days out; 12-hour days.

Main Responsibilities

- Develop and facilitate the implementation of health and safety risk assessment and action plans and safe operating procedures in a manner which meets best practice standards and ensures continuous improvement in the reduction of accidents and injuries within the mine.
- Monitor and report on the health and safety performance of the mine and provide recommendations for enhancements and improvements.
- Support the development of a culture based on ownership and accountability to increase health and safety awareness.
- Work in a collaborative spirit with onsite health and safety leadership, teammates, and other departments.
- Develop and maintain open working relationships with all teams on-site.
- Ensure knowledge of occupational health and safety regulations and applicable acts and codes is kept current and up to date.
- Adhere to Osisko/ Barkerville Gold Mine's Safety Procedures and other company policies.
- Identify, investigate, report, and provide input regarding the causes of safety incidents and identify prevention strategies.
- Support the internal and external audit requirements and make recommendations for improved performance relating to areas of non-compliance.
- Responsible for reducing work-related injuries by continuously improving the safety management system and engaging employees on all levels.
- Advise and assist with creating, editing, and implementing department specific safe operating procedures and policies.
- Ensure compliance with all safety requirements, including drug and alcohol policy, and other work site rules, and regulations.
- Administer Drug and Alcohol tests that may be related to incident investigations.

- Administer first aid as required and regulatory requirements of OFA 3.
- Work with the Health and Safety Superintendent and WorkSafeBC on injury management.
- Assist with the coordination of disability management and promote the return-to-work program.
- Assist supervisors in investigating incidents on site and bring them to sign-off points.
- Deliver orientations as needed.
- Assist or hold with Mine Rescue Team functions and practices.
- Perform other duties as required.

- 5 years Industry experience – Underground mining; oil and gas; and/or related heavy industries.
- National Construction Safety Officer (NCSO)
- Must have current Level 3 Occupational First Aid certificate - must have experience.
- Certificate in Health and Safety Management

- Incident investigation experience, SCAT or Tap Root experience
- Inspection knowledge – familiar with industry equipment
- Underground or surface mine rescue training or willing to be trained
- Training as a fit tester-able to fit test workers an asset

- Fall Protection certificate – comfortable working at heights
- Confined Space certificate – experience working in/with confined spaces
